Round	Saturday – WA70m, WA60m (Cadet), WA50 (Compound) ranking rounds followed by Head to Heads. Sunday – WA70m, WA60m (Cadet), WA50 (Compound) ranking rounds followed by Head to Heads.

Practice	No practice will be available on Friday. Please do not enter the field to erect tents on the tournament field before 17:00 on Friday and then only with the consent of the Field Party.			
Registration	Registration from 8.00am. If you are not yet in possession of a 2017/2018 card, please bring proof that you have paid your membership to your club.			
Event Timings	Assembly at 8.45am. 2 Ends of Practice from 09:00am both days The competition will start immediately afterwards.			
Event Format	<p><b>Saturday</b> WA70m Round for Recurve, Barebow and Longbow shot on a 122cm full face WA60m Round for Recurve, Barebow and Longbow Cadets &amp; Seniors shot on a 122cm full face. WA50m Round for Compound with each Archer shooting on an individual 80cm 6 ring face.</p> <p>These ranking rounds will be shot in a double detail with 6 arrows shot in four minutes with timing lights. A series of head to head matches will follow. It is expected that all archers will proceed to the Head to Head matches, but a cut maybe applied dependant on the number of entries and timing. Higher placed archers may receive a “bye” in the first round.</p> <p>Note: Barebow and Longbow archers are welcome to shoot in the Head to Head, however in-line with World Archery rules they will be classified as (and therefore shoot alongside) recurve Archers.</p> <p><b>Sunday</b> The same format as Saturday</p>			
Scoring	Scoring on both days will be on Ianseo three dozen score sheets and additionally with electronic scoring aids.			
Awards	There will be Vouchers awarded from the “The Archery Shop” dependant on the number of entrants per category set on the closing date of entry for the competition (subject to conformation) Medal awards will also be dependent on the number of entries per category.			
Drug Testing	Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing. Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply. Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result. Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (Under 18’s) to be drug tested if approached.			
Lost Arrows	Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party (please remember to inform them if you later find the arrow). It is the archer’s responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the field.			
Photography	In line with the recommendation in the Archery GB Safeguarding Policy, those who wish to take photographs or video at this event are to register with the Tournament Secretary on arrival. Unauthorised photography is not permitted.			
Refreshments	Food and Refreshments will be available throughout the weekend.			
Camping	There is no camping on site but there are several sites around Basingstoke.			
Special Note	Archers who are unable to get to the target should arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection.			
Bosses	Tenzon Targets Layered foam bosses will be used for all classes.			

Smoking	Designated smoking area - 10m behind the tent line. Please note that this rule applies to those using electronic cigarettes.
Stoves & Burners	Please do not put stoves, burners or hot water urns directly on the grass.
Pets	Please do not bring pets onto the playing fields.
