Awards:	<i>Top 3 Places for each category: Recurve Men, Women; Compound Men; Women.</i>
Dress:	<i>Please refer to the Archery GB Rules of Shooting for the dress regulations. Archers should comply with dress regulations until the event finishes.</i>
Drug Testing:	<p><i>Archers competing at record status tournaments may be liable for drugs testing.</i> <i>Competitors who are approached to give samples must comply.</i> <i>Non-compliance will be treated as a positive result.</i> <i>Parents / Guardians must sign the relevant box on the entry forms giving consent for junior archers (under 18s) to be drug tested if approached.</i></p>
